★ IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- You must be a New York resident to apply to any Zeta Charter School.
- Applicants must be entering Pre-Kindergarten through 3rd grade. While Zeta Schools plan to offer Pre-Kindergarten through 12th grade, in 2020-21, Zeta Bronx 1 will serve Kindergarten (K) through 3rd grade, Zeta Bronx Tremont Park will serve K and 1st grade, Zeta Inwood 1 will serve PK through 3rd grade, and Zeta Bronx 3 will serve K.
- Your child must be 4 years old on or before December 31, 2020 to apply to Pre-Kindergarten, and 5 years old on or before December 31, 2020 to apply to Kindergarten.
- This application is for Zeta Charter Schools only. It is not affiliated with other New York City charter schools or Department of Education applications.
- If applying for more than one child, we strongly recommend only applying to schools that offer all of your children's grades.
- Review carefully before submitting. Answer all questions, as blank fields may result in an unprocessed application

6 PRE-KINDERGARTEN LOTTERY PREFERENCES FOR THE 2020-21 SCHOOL YEAR

Pre-K applicants who meet certain low income and special needs criteria are eligible for preferences in our admissions lottery for Head Start pre-K spots (if any). We are accordingly collecting income and special needs information from Pre-K applicant families. This information will be used solely for determining admissions preferences in our lottery, and will not be used for any other purpose.

To qualify for our income-based lottery admissions preference, please answer the following questions (if your child is admitted under this preference, you will be required to provide proof of your household's annual income):

1. How many people live in the child's household? (The household includes everyone living together in the same home who is financially supported by the child's parent(s) or guardian(s) AND is related to the child's parent(s) or guardian(s) by blood, marriage, or adoption.)
2. What is your household's annual income before taxes (including earnings by all household members and all types of earnings, such as salary, wages, unemployment, and public benefits)?
3. Does the child's family (living in the same household) currently receive any public assistance (such as Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) or Supplemental Security Income (SSI))? Yes No
