- You must be a New York resident to apply to any Zeta Charter School.
- Applicants must be entering Pre-Kindergarten through 4th grade.
- Your child must be 4 years old on or before December 31, 2021 to apply to Pre-Kindergarten, and 5 years old on or before December 31, 2021 to apply to Kindergarten.
- This application is for Zeta Charter Schools only. It is not affiliated with other New York City charter schools or Department of Education applications.
- If applying for more than one child, we strongly recommend only applying to schools that offer all of your children's grades.
- Review carefully before submitting. Answer all questions, as blank fields may result in an unprocessed application.

Ranking a school at the top or bottom of the list will not increase or decrease your chances of acceptance into that school. Ranking is used only to assign your child to your preferred Zeta Charter School if he or she is accepted to more than one school.

2. Do not assign the same number to more than one school.

If accepted at more than one school, we will only reserve a seat for your child at the school with the higher ranking.
